AMSEL, CLARK

A prank? No- The ship is a wreck. Haven't you noticed?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Can't notice much from the podbay.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Oh, that's who took the photocopies of the sheeps. Archivist Henri Fairweather. Have you seen Tom Wreke?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

I-- No. I tried to email him that I was trapped, but he didn't reply. It was work hours, so I assumed... Why?

AMSEL, CLARK

He's missing, along with a few other members of the crew.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

How long have you been down here?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

What do you mean missing?

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Their ID tags are nowhere on board. The internal communication systems on board have been compromised, so I couldn't find you down here. Sorry! Or else I would have gotten you out with the doors. You must not have had permissions to be down here with your own card? How'd you get in here, anyways? Did one of the engineers leave it open?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Not this time. Dave pushed me in here and closed the doors. I thought it was his idea of a joke, but...

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Dave? Which, we have a lot of Daves. Specialist Dave Fenne? The one with the blue hair?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Yes. That asshole.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Oh, that's not very nice.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

How long have you been here? You look like you were in the middle of trying to open up one of the pods.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

I don't know. There's no clocks in here, and my comm is dead.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

How many sleeps have you had?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

...Shit.

AMSEL, CLARK

That's not the best way to measure time, Teddy.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

You said Tom's ID tags were missing? Any idea where he actually is?

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

No clue. They're not on the ship. Dave said that he was going to try to locate the decommissioned rover Valour, though. The ship hasn't moved since, so I do have the coordinates for where that is. Maybe he took Tom with him? Tom is an engineer, and he works with the rovers.

FAIRWEATHER. HENRI

You don't know where Dave is either, then.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

No. There are a number of people missing.

AMSEL, CLARK

Laurel Scoresby and Andrew Brookshaw are also missing.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Christ. You say 'missing'. The others didn't have a chance to evacuate, did they?

AMSEL, CLARK

Everyone else on the ship is dead.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Clark says that he hasn't identified all of the bodies yet. He's a black box technician.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

That's-- Oh my God. ... How many are unidentified?

AMSEL, CLARK

There's too many for me to do it all on my own.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

They didn't send a friend with Clark to do work, which seems silly.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Are they even identifiable? I don't know what happened, but it's been.. I've been trapped here for a while, they can't be pretty.

AMSEL, CLARK

Some are... worse than others.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

The cryo-preservation lab might still be in good condition. It's chilly there. Brrr. But you don't have mittens, so I guess you can't go in.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Is anyone in there? In cryo-stasis, I mean.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

I can't tell, it's like someone blotted out parts of the map on board. We could check! If you find some mittens. Or else you'll get cold.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Alright, Teddy. We'll find some mittens.

AMSEL, CLARK

Where would we get mittens?

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

There's a shop where Tom buys his work gloves. Are those like mittens?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Close enough.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Okay, let's go there? Do you want to make a stop by your quarters first? To wash your hands.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Later.

AMSEL, CLARK

Are you alright? I know this is a lot...

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Understatement of the century.

AMSEL, CLARK

I'm used to things like this.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

I'll be fine when we find T-- when we find them.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Also, if you want to open one of the pods, you have to reach behind it and disengage the tether with the claw grips.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Instead of... kicking it? I think Tom calls that 'manual reconfiguration using percussive translocation.' But it's just kicking its.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Anyways! Let's go find some mittens.
