**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY Oh, yeah, Clark's just scared though.

SCORESBY, LAUREL ...Why are you scared? You didn't hear anything untoward, did you?

AMSEL, CLARK Thank you for that, Teddy.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY You're welcome!

AMSEL, CLARK I was worried something was going to happen to you. But I think it's normal to be afraid when you're stuck in a ghost ship being shepherded around by a maniac.

## SCORESBY, LAUREL

Fair play. We were concerned he might have circled back around to you two. The room was empty. Er- of anyone living. We did certainly see evidence of his handiwork.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY It's like Frankenstein, Nina read that book to me.

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL Y...es. Like Frankenstein.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY Does that mean that Dave was looking?

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL I imagine he's figured out a way to monitor the ship remotely through the cameras.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY Oh. So can he see us?

SCORESBY, LAUREL Well, judging from the fact someone smashed in the camera in the corner of this room, no, I don't think so.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY Oh. Who broke that?

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL Possibly Sylvester? There were shards of blackened glass in the front of his uniform.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY That's weird. Why would he do that?

**SCORESBY**, LAUREL He may have wanted to cover up the fact he was stealing.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Did he have weapons on him?

#### SCORESBY, LAUREL

He had an expandable nightstick in his shirt, but I imagine Fenne must have looted his body prior to dumping him for dead in the elevator car. The nightstick looked like a little pillbox, so Fenne must have mistaken it for being useless.

**AMSEL**, CLARK Why would he attack his friend?

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY Maybe something else got to Dr. Sylvester first? Or he tried to stop him from doing something. Remember? He said if bad things happened to the people he liked, that was just the cost of business.

**SCORESBY**, LAUREL Rather cold, if that's true.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY Maybe he was already dead looking though, so Dave just took his stuff.

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL I suppose that's a possibility... Why wouldn't he at least attempt to dispose of the body respectfully?

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY He put all the rest of them inside of the shaft. I think comparatively that was nice.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Maybe he didn't have the time.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY So what was following him?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI It could've been someone else.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY Who could it be?

AMSEL, CLARK Maybe Tom, or Brookshaw?

SCORESBY, LAUREL Tom wouldn't.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY No, not Tom! It doesn't sound very much like Brookshaw. The lieutenant isn't very nice, but he just yells, he doesn't hits.

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL Is it possible that there's someone else on board?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Shit.

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL U.R.S.A, are there any more mobile tags?

### U.R.S.A, TEDDY

There are... But I think at least a few of them are just Dave putting bodies into the moonpool's circulation tank. Because they've just been going around in circles and circles and circles. Someone's activated the air spigots in the car shafts too, so things are uhm, bumpy.

**SCORESBY**, LAUREL Well that's macabre.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY Yeah, it's icky.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Disgusting.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY It's like he's making people soup.

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL That... Don't say that again.

AMSEL, CLARK Great.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Ew.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY Maybe he's getting rid of evidence?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Maybe the corpse was bait.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY Bait?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Well. "Corpse."

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY He's not a worm though. Tom told me, you can put worms on the end of the hooks. But he doesn't like doing that. So he uses fake ones. They're colourful.

**AMSEL,** CLARK Not that kind of bait, Teddy.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Something to lure us into the elevator.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY Oh, because he dropped you like an egg?

## FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

I-- I'd rather you not call it that, but yes. Speaking of bait. Before he dropped the elevator, Dave made it sound like Tom was near him.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY I'm not worried about Tom. Tom could totally kick Dave's ass. He broke the top of an elevator! That's way cool.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Still.

AMSEL, CLARK Don't swear, Teddy.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY That's silly.

**AMSEL**, CLARK Swearing is rude.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY Why is it rude?

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI It hardly matters, at this point.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY Henri says fuck the rules.

AMSEL, CLARK Teddy!

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI Back to what I was saying...

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL I don't think that Tom would have let himself be taken hostage.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY Yeah, because he could kick anyone's ass. He's cool.

**SCORESBY**, LAUREL It doesn't seem particularly feasible. Dave is quite small by comparison.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY Well, if Tom was going to the library connection with the cars, maybe Dave lied to him? And said oh I have your Henri so you have to come with me or else he DIES.

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL That could be an angle.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI He did trap me in the pod bay.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY So maybe he was going to go get you afterwards as proof?

**FAIRWEATHER,** HENRI I doubt it. He could've pulled up the security feed.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY Maybe Tom wouldn't believe just a feed? Dave's good at faking things.

**AMSEL**, CLARK I hate Dave more with each passing moment.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI There were times in the pod bay that I thought I heard people, but-- I don't know. I was alone in there for days, and it was so quiet.

#### U.R.S.A, TEDDY

Maybe he was redirecting people away from the bay? If he didn't want anyone leaving.

## FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Maybe.

## U.R.S.A, TEDDY

You should probably wash up in the sink beside the tasers. It's a little bathroom, but you can at least clean your face.

## FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

Hah. Thanks for telling me I smell, Teddy.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY You're welcome!

## SCORESBY, LAUREL

We should probably plan out other bases in case we need to mobilize. Figure out which weapons would be most efficient to carryand cache on progressively fanning out radius runs. Pick out locations that are a balance of strategically isolated and accessible enough in a pinch.

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY We can look at maps together!

SCORESBY, LAUREL That would be helpful.

AMSEL, CLARK The dead areas might be good places to start.

FAIRWEATHER, HENRI You good with any weapons, Clark?

AMSEL, CLARK Not really?

**FAIRWEATHER,** HENRI We'll have to find something that you can use, then. I'm sure there's something around here.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY Does Clark even want to use one?

**SCORESBY**, LAUREL At least take one of the tasers. They're non lethal.

U.R.S.A, TEDDY But you didn't ask him!

**SCORESBY,** LAUREL When he's carrying you around U.R.S.A, he doesn't get a choice.

**U.R.S.A,** TEDDY That's not very nice.

# SCORESBY, LAUREL

Do you know how expensive you are? You're also maintaining life support. He can set aside his particular convictions, or whatever else is holding him up for that.

### FAIRWEATHER, HENRI

It's that or lose an eye. If he's lucky.

AMSEL, CLARK I hate this ship.

**FAIRWEATHER,** HENRI You and me both.

**AMSEL**, CLARK I should have just gone home this month instead of next month-

**U.R.S.A**, TEDDY But then you wouldn't have met me!

**SCORESBY**, LAUREL I suppose U.R.S.A has you there.

AMSEL, CLARK Fair point.
